annyeonghi gaseyo

Goodbye

(to someone leaving)

안녕히 계세요

annyeonghi gyeseyo

Goodbye

(to someone staying)

다녀오세요

danyeooseyo

See you later

(to someone leaving and returning)

또 봐요

tto bwayo

See you again

The 2 most important Korean greetings to remember :

- 안녕하세요 (annyeonghaseyo) - "Hello" (polite)
- 안녕히 가세요 / 안녕히 계세요 (annyeonghi gaseyo / annyeonghi gyeseyo) - "Goodbye" (depending on who's leaving)

These cover everyday hello and goodbye situations respectfully.
