- なる (naru) – to become (verb)
- あるひ (aru hi) – one day (noun/expression)

- いっしょに (issho ni) – together (adverb)
- しょう (shiyou) – let's (do) (verb/volitional form)
- いう (iu) – to say (verb)
- ふたり (futari) – two people (noun)
- ほん (hon) – book (noun)

- やさしい (yasashii) – kind, gentle (i-adjective)
- おしえる (oshieru) – to teach (verb)

- すこしずつ (sukoshi zutsu) – little by little (adverb)
- わかる (wakaru) – to understand (verb)
- がんばる (ganbaru) – to try hard (verb)
- いま (ima) – now (noun/adverb)
- たのしい (tanoshii) – fun, enjoyable (i-adjective)
- ありがとう (arigatou) – thank you (expression)

Grammar

- は (wa) – topic marker
- を (o) – direct object marker
- が (ga) – subject marker
- と (to) – and (listing nouns), with, or quoting speech
- に (ni) – direction/time marker
- です (desu) – polite sentence ending (to be)
- ます (masu) – polite verb ending
- たい (tai) – want to (verb stem + たい)
- とおもう (to omou) – "I think..."
- だから (dakara) – so, therefore
- でも (demo) – but
- まいにち (mainichi) – every day (used as a time adverb)
- すこし (sukoshi) – a little (adverb)
- ずつ (zutsu) – by (increments); used in すこしずつ
- と (to) – quoting particle (after direct speech)
- しょう (shiyou) – let's do (volitional form of する)
- くれます (kuremasu) – to do something for me (giver is not the speaker)
- ありがとうといいます (arigatou to iimasu) – say "thank you"
- なる (naru) – to become (verb)
