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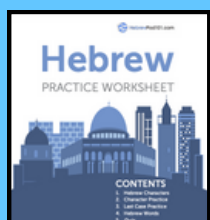

1	Please	בבקשה	bevakasha	Also means “you’re welcome”
2	Thank you	תודה	toda	Universal
3	Thank you very much	תודה רבה	toda raba	Warm, common
4	Thanks a lot	תודה רבה מאוד	toda raba me’od	Extra appreciation
5	You’re welcome	בבקשה	bevakasha	Same as “please”
6	Excuse me / Sorry	סליחה	slichah	Flexible
7	Pardon me?	סליחה?	slichah?	Asking to repeat
8	Sorry (apology)	מצטער / מצטערת	mitzta’er / mitzta’eret	Male / female speaker
9	Sorry about that	סליחה על זה	slichah al ze	Casual apology
10	Sorry, my mistake	טעות שלי	ta’ut sheli	Very common
11	Yes, please	כן, בבקשה	ken, bevakasha	Polite acceptance
12	No, thank you	לא, תודה	lo, toda	Polite refusal
13	Nice to meet you	נעים מאוד	na’im me’od	First meetings
14	Thanks anyway	תודה בכל מקרה	toda bekhoh mikreh	Polite decline
15	Appreciate it	מעריך / מעריכה	ma’arikh / ma’arikhah	Warm

17	All good / No problem	הכל בסדר	hakol beseder	Reassuring
18	All good, thanks	הכל טוב, תודה	hakol tov, toda	Casual close
19	Of course	בטח	betakh	Casual agreement
20	Sure	בוודאי	bevaday	Neutral-polite
21	Please (warmer)	בבקשה רבה	bevakasha raba	Softer
22	Thank you for your help	תודה על העזרה	toda al ha-ezra	Very safe
23	Excuse me (passing by)	סליחה רגע	slichah rega	Common in public
24	Much appreciated	תודה, ממש	toda, mamash	Casual emphasis
25	Have a nice day	יום טוב	yom tov	Very common in shops
26	Good luck	בהצלחה	behatzlacha	Universal
27	Take care	תשמור על עצמך / תשמרי על עצמך	tishmor al atsmekha / tishmeri al atsmekh	Male / female listener
28	Good health	לבריאות	labri'ut	Said after sneezing, drinking, or even coughing
29	In good health (response)	לחיים	lechaim	Literally "to life," tied to Jewish culture
30	With God's help	בעזרת השם	be'ezrat ha-Shem	Common in speech, even among secular Israelis

31	Congratulations / good for you	כל הכבוד	kol hakavod	Praising effort, not just results
32	Go in peace	סע לשלום / לכי לשלום	sa leshalom / lekhi leshalom	Very Hebrew phrasing
33	Come in peace (response)	חזור בשלום	khazor beshalom	Cultural pair phrase
34	May it be for good	שיהיה לטובה	sheyihyeh letova	Used when unsure or hoping
35	May you be blessed	תתברך / תתברכי	titbarekh / titbarkhi	Rare in English equivalents
36	May you hear good news	בשורות טובות	besorot tovo	After something stressful or uncertain
37	Only good things	רק טוב	rak tov	Warm closing, texts or in person
38	May it pass easily	שיעבור בקלות	sheya'avor bekalut	Before tests, procedures, hard tasks
39	Strong health	בריאות שלמה	bri'ut shlema	Visiting someone sick
40	Go with strength	תתחזק	titchazek	Encouragement
41	Enjoy yourself	תיהנה / תהני	teihane / teihani	Said sincerely, very common
42	Sweet dreams	חלומות פז	khalomot paz	Old-fashioned but still heard
43	Welcome	ברוך הבא / ברוכה הבאה	barukh haba / brukha haba'ah	Literal blessing language
44	May you succeed	שתצליח / שתצליחי	shetatsliakh / shetatslikhi	Pre-task encouragement

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
