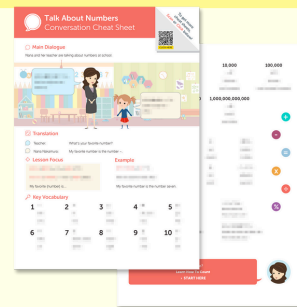

| Water, please.        | 물 주세요.     | Mul juseyo.         |
| More water, please.   | 물 좀 더 주세요. | Mul jom deo juseyo. |

| It's too spicy.           | 너무 매워요.        | Neomu maewoyo.                      |
| I like this.              | 이거 좋아요.        | Igeo johayo.                        |
| I love this.              | 이거 사랑해요.       | Igeo saranghaeyo.                   |
| I love Korean food        | 한국 음식을 사랑해요.   | Hanguk eumsigeul saranghaeyo.       |

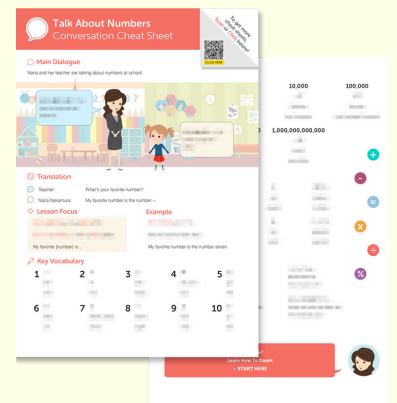
