## 1. Me llamo [A].

- **Meaning** - My name is [A].
- **Example** - Me llamo Luis. (My name is Luis.)

## 2. ¿Dónde está [A (noun: singular)]?

- **Meaning** - Where is [A (noun)]?
- **Example** - ¿Dónde está el baño? (Where is the bathroom?)

## 3. ¿Dónde están [A (noun: plural)]?

- **Meaning** - Where are [A (noun: plural)]?
- **Example** - ¿Dónde están los chocolates? (Where are the chocolates?)

## 4. Soy [A (noun or adjective)].

- **Meaning** - I am [A (noun or adjective)].
- **Example** - Soy guapo. (I am handsome.)

## 5. ¿De dónde [A (verb)] [B (noun/pronoun)]?

- **Meaning** - Where [A (verb)] [B (noun/pronoun)] from?
- **Example** - ¿De dónde son ellos? (Where are they from?)

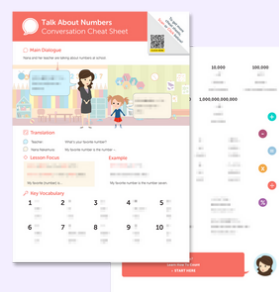

## 6. ¿Tú [A (verb)] [B (noun)]?

- **Meaning** - Do you [A (verb)] [B (noun)]?
- **Example** - ¿Tú cantas ópera? (Do you sing opera?)

## 7. Yo vivo en [A (noun)], en [B (noun)].

- **Meaning** - I live in [A (noun)], in [B (noun)].
- **Example** - Yo vivo en Chihuahua, en México. (I live in Chihuahua, in Mexico.)

## 8. Me gusta [A (verb)] [B (noun)].

- **Meaning** - I like to [A (verb)] [B (noun)].
- **Example** - Me gusta cocinar comida mexicana.  
(I like to cook Mexican food.)

## 9. ¿Puedes [A (verb)]?

- **Meaning** - Can you [A (verb)]?
- **Example** - ¿Puedes cocinar? (Can you cook?)

## 10. Yo [A (verb)] en [B (noun: place)].

- **Meaning** - I [A (verb)] in [B (noun: place)].
- **Example** - Yo enseño en la universidad.  
(I teach in the university.)

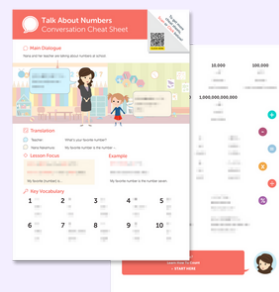
